Triveni Coop. Urban Thrift & Credit Society Ltd. Vs. RCS.

1. Counsel for Appellant submitted that the Assistant Registrar rejected the proposal for registration of society in the title Triveni Coop. Urban Thrift & Credit Society Ltd. (proposed) with the observation that "there appears to be no justification for allowing fresh registration of thrift & credit Society in the area in question". This order was conveyed by the Assistant Registrar vide letter dated 04.12.2014.
2. A notice dated 03.03.2015 was issued to RCS to submit the reply to the revision petition. But no one appeared on behalf of the RCS. Therefore, I decided to proceed in the matter on the basis of facts and circumstances available on record.
3. RCS in its order did not furnish any cogent reason on the basis of which he drew the conclusion that there appears to be no justification for allowing fresh registration of thrift & credit Society in the area in question. RCS failed to clarify how the 1310 T&C Societies for Delhi, 128 T&C Societies for North East Zone and 2 T&C Societies in locality/area named 'Sonia Vihar' as adequate and there is no requirement of further more T&C Societies.
4. Appellant in its appeal also submitted that RCS office did not provide any opportunity of being heard and to submit his submission in favour of requirement of fresh new registration of T&C societies in that particular area.
5. Considering the above facts and to meet the end of justice, orders dated 04.12.2014 and 25.02.2014 are set aside and case is remanded back to RCS with the directions to pass a well reasoned order after providing due opportunity of being heard to the Appellant. The order should be passed preferably within six weeks after the pronouncement of this order.
6. File be consigned to record room after completion.
