Raghu Friends Coop. Urban Thrift & Credit Society Ltd.

1. Counsel for Appellant submitted that the Assistant Registrar rejected the proposal for registration of society in the title Raghu Friends Coop. Urban Thrift & Credit Society Ltd. (proposed) vide order dated 17.10.2014 with the observation that "there appears to be no justification for allowing fresh registration of thrift & credit Society in the area in question" which is not a permissible reason for rejecting as per law.
2. A notice dated 09.03.2015 was issued to RCS to submit the reply to the appeal. But no one appeared on behalf of the RCS. Therefore, I decided to proceed in the matter on the basis of facts and circumstances available on record.
3. Assistant Registrar rejected the proposal from the society as it was not in prescribed format and there appears to be no justification for allowing fresh registration of thrift & credit Society in the area in question.
4. RCS in its order dated 17.10.2014 did not furnish any cogent reason on the basis of which Assistant Registrar drew the conclusion that there appears to be no justification for allowing fresh registration of thrift & credit Society in the area in question.
5. Appellant in its appeal also submitted that RCS office rejected the application as it was not in the prescribe format and prescribed manner but RCS office did not raise any query before rejecting the proposal/application for registration.
6. Considering the above facts and to meet the end of justice, order dated 17.10.2014 is set aside and case is remanded back to RCS with the directions to pass a well reasoned order after providing due opportunity of being heard to the Appellant. The order should be passed preferably within six weeks after the pronouncement of this order.
7. File be consigned to record room after completion.
