1. Counsel for the Petitioners submitted that he has received an eviction notice dated 21.08.2015 from BDO (N/W) with a direction to evict the suit land within 7 days. The said eviction order was passed pursuant to demarcation conducted by Revenue officials on 11.05.2015. However, no notice was issued to the petitioner before demarcation. Hence, the eviction notice is illegal.
2. Counsel for the Gaon Sabha submitted that if the petitioners have any grievance against the demarcation, then he may approach the revenue authorities for fresh demarcation.
3. Above contention of the Counsel for Gaon Sabha is not opposed by Counsel for the petitioners.
4. In view of the submissions made by the Counsels for the parties, the present petition is hereby remanded back to SDM/RA with a direction to dispose off the same, within 2 months from the date of this order.
5. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
