Sh. S.C. Tuli Vs. The RCS & Anr.

1. Heard the Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner. The Counsel for the petitioner stated that however the loan was availed by the petitioner but the same was fully paid by Sh. S.C. Tuli, the petitioner. The Counsel for the Petitioners has also produced a copy of the certificate issued to Sh. S.C. Tuli by the Society which states as under:

“We certify that as per record of the society your Loan dues of Rs. 60,000-00 (Sixty thousand only) has been fully paid on 30.08.2004 alongwith the interest dues.”

2. In the light of above, I am of the opinion that justice will be fully served if the present petition of the petitioner is forwarded to the Assistant Collector concerned with a direction to treat the same as representation and decide as per law after granting opportunity of being heard to the petitioner and pass a speaking order. Till such order is passed, no coercive action be taken against the petitioner.
3. The case is disposed of accordingly.
4. Copy of this order be given ‘Dasti’ to the petitioner as requested.
