Corrigendum of order dated 30.05.2014

1. The above noted revision petition was decided through an order dated May 30, 2014 of this Court, thereby remanding the matter to the Revenue Assistant to pass a fresh order.
2. Counsel for the petitioner has now filed an application under section 152 read with section 151 CPC for modification/correction in the said order. In the application it has been prayed that since the matter pertains to Consolidation, therefore, the matter should have been remanded to the Consolidation Officer and not to the Revenue Assistant, as ordered in the remand order.
3. I have considered the application filed by the petitioner.
4. The word "Revenue Assistant" in para 4 of the order dated May 30, 2014 may, therefore, now be read as "Consolidation Officer". Rest of the contents of the said order shall remain unchanged.
