1. Heard the Counsel. He has stated that main Counsel could not appear in this case on 15.07.2014 due to some other urgent business and the case was dismissed for want of prosecution. The Proxy Counsel prayed that the present petition may be restored. The same is allowed.
2. The Petitioner filed the revision petition against the mutation order of Tehsildar which is appealable before the concerned Deputy Commissioner. The Proxy Counsel further conceded that the order of Tehsildar is appealable before the Deputy Commissioner and agreed to withdraw the case with liberty to file afresh before the Deputy Commissioner. The prayer of the Proxy Counsel is allowed and this petition is disposed of with the liberty to file afresh before the concerned Deputy Commissioner. The case is disposed of accordingly.
